

## **Eligibility Requirements for Regimental Commuters**

Any cadet who has 8 semesters within the Regiment of Cadets and has 12 credits or less remaining in order to graduate may be eligible for Regimental Commuter status.

Any cadet who has 12 credits or less remaining in order to graduate may be eligible for Regimental Commuter status. Some cadets may have had previous transferable credits or have taken more credits during their time at the Academy and have not had eight semesters within the Regiment of Cadets.

Any question as to who how many credits a cadet has remaining should be referred to the Office of the Registrar.

There are some cadets who will have a lab for one credit putting them above the 12 credit limit however they have been approved since that one lab meets every other week.

Cadets who are Veterans, are married, may request Regimental Commuters status, regardless of their class or length of time at the Academy.

Cadets who are licensed majors, Marine Engine and Marine Transportation, must remain in the Regiment of Cadets while as a Regimental Commuter.

Cadets who are Regimental Commuters are subject to random drug testing and all rules and regulations as specified in the Regimental Manual. A Regimental Commuter who fails to report for mandatory drug testing will be subject to disciplinary action and dismissal from the Academy.

Regimental Commuters who are selected for random drug testing are notified the day before by email and by phone.

Parking for Regimental Commuters is the same as for all cadets. They must purchase a parking pass from Public Safety.

All Regimental Commuters will be charged a flat fee, through the Business Office, by Chartwells in order to eat in the dining facility. This is not optional. Whether a cadet eats one meal or all meals, the price is the same and that is for each semester for the period of time the cadet is a Regimental Commuter.

Regimental Commuters cannot reside in the dormitory at any time. Some have attempted in the past to reside in the dormitory for various reasons but it must be made clear to all Regimental Commuters that this is not authorized and they will be subject to disciplinary action.

Regimental Commuters are not exempt from specified Regimental obligations such as Change of Command.

When directed by the 3<sup>rd</sup> Co Officer, the Regimental Commuter may be required to attend morning formation.
