ACTION ITEMS:

- WATCH RELIEF** pass down information is critically important to fulfilling safe ship operations. Always make note of issues that occurred and solutions while on watch – then pass it down.
- ALL CADET OFFICERS OF THE WATCH (COW)** must familiarize themselves with procedures posted in the MMA Emergency Preparedness Guide located on the forward bulkhead of the watch office.
- FIRE ALARMS:** Use of ship’s fire alarm box on building across from gangway. Cadets should dial 9-9-911 to call Bourne Fire Department onboard (or 911 on a cell phone), or pull fire alarm box on building across from gangway. Proper use of ship’s fire detection panel is fully detailed in the Standing Orders for Buzzards Bay – learn them before assuming the watch.
- All persons boarding must display a photo ID in a clear sleeve – if you have a TWIC – this must be displayed. Only TWIC holders can escort visitors or contractors.
- Watchstanding is fundamental to MMA’s leadership program. Upperclass cadets need to share watchstanding knowledge and introduce the underclass to their future responsibilities. Use the Inport Standing Orders as the base line.

INFORMATION ITEMS:

- SHIPBOARD MAINTENANCE:** Maintenance will be held daily Mon-Fri at 0800 and at 1300. Please be advised that your Student ID is required to sign in/out of maintenance sessions. General make-up periods: December 09-13 and 16-20.
- 1/C MENG & MTRA:** Any 1/C MENG & MTRA graduating December, 2019 must submit their application packet no later than **September 30**; Seniors graduating June 2020 must submit their application packet no later than **October 31** to Mariner Credentialing Office, 2nd Fl., Harrington Bldg.
